



# ACTION REQUIRED

**Goal:** To create an account on ToonDoo, an online comic-book-maker and become familiar with the features of the program **before** your next Spanish class. If you do not have access to the Internet at home, you must make arrangements to create an account at school before/after school in room 203, during ELO, or in the after-school PBL lab.

**Directions:**

- Go to the following website: <http://www.toondoo.com/>
- Click on the red rectangle located in the top right corner that says 'Sign Up For FREE'.
- Click on the blue rectangle located on the right that says 'Sign up for ToonDoo'.
- Enter a username and a password that you WON'T forget! Then enter your MPS student email address.
- Click on 'Register.'
- Once registered, log in using your new username and password.
- Click on the blue arrow to the right that says 'Create'.
- Select a multi-box configuration, like the three-frame comic like this:
- Play around with the site, getting acquainted with the technology. Peruse (look through) all of the options for characters, settings, props, backgrounds, etc. to become familiar.
- **Next class you will have a performance assessment in which you will create a comic in Spanish to meet certain requirements – i.e. evidence for the MYP D criterion.**
