

## Actividad #6 – Criteria A and B – Speaking and Listening Practice

Learning Intention: We're learning to...	Success Criteria: We'll know we're successful when...
- create grammatically correct sentence structures using gustar and ser.	- we can create sentences using the different forms of gustar (me, te, le, nos, les) and ser (soy, eres, es, son, somos) correctly to play Jenga.

### Directions:

1. Set up the Jenga game quickly as one would normally do to play. Make sure you do so on a steady surface.
2. Each partner will take turns pulling out a Jenga piece, ~~trying not to make the~~ whole structure fall. He/she will then look at the number written on the Jenga piece.
3. He/she then looks at the number on the table below and creates a sentence in Spanish that communicates the idea.
4. The rest of the group uses the answer key on back to check if he/she is right.
