Criteria A –Oral Communication

This center will help you practice:

- holding an extemporaneous conversation (i.e. not planned/scripted) expressing your likes and dislikes
- remembering how to say and include topics from previous unit, like:
 - greeting,
 - exchanging names,
 - exchanging feelings,
 - asking the time,
 - asking how to say/spell a word,
 - saying goodbye
- asking and answering the following unit questions:
 - What do you like to do? I like to...(a lot).
 - What don't you like to do? I don't like to...(at all).
 - Do you like to...(something specific)?
 - When it's (sunny) in the (summer), what do you like to do?

1. Work with a partner. Hold a two-minute conversation in pure Spanish. Don't use any English and try to talk about as much of the above stuff as possible.
